

**United Kingdom Wayfarer Association
50th Anniversary National Championship 2008**

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO RACE

The 2008 Wayfarer National Championship will be sailed under the burgee of Parkstone Yacht Club from Sunday 24th to Friday 29th August as part of Poole Week 2008. The Organising Authority of the event will be the joint Race Committees of the host club and the UKWA. The event will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the UKWA Class Association rules, and the PYC sailing instructions.

Competitors for the National Championship must prove current membership of a Wayfarer national class association affiliated to Wayfarer International Committee at registration.

Scrutineering will take place in the reception area from 1400–1700 hours on the Saturday, and from 0930-1200 hours on Sunday. Competitors are urged to arrive early enough to complete scrutineering before the first points race. However, in exceptional circumstance (eg travel problems on the day) boats may be scrutineered after the first race by agreement with the UKWA racing committee.

A valid Wayfarer measurement certificate must be available for inspection during scrutineering.

Schedule of Races

It is intended to hold one race on each day from Sunday 24th August to Friday 29th August as part of Poole Week. A second race may be held on one or more days to replace any cancelled races.

Start times to be confirmed.

The championship will consist of a minimum of four and a maximum of six races. If six races are completed, one race will be discarded.

Racing Area and Courses

Racing will take place in Poole Harbour. Diagrams of the racing area and lists of marks will be made available on a separate sheet to competitors provided by the host club.

Entry fee

The combined entry fee for Poole Week and the UKWA National Championship has not been confirmed by PYC but is likely to be in the region of £75.
